

Georgia DECA's Civic Consciousness Project

The purpose of this activity is to celebrate DECA by giving the gift of community service to each DECA chapter's local community. Each chapter is encouraged to analyze its community's needs and identify a service project(s) to benefit that community. There are no restrictions on the type of project(s) a chapter may select; the only requirement is that the project(s) benefit the community. The Civic Consciousness Project should be the chapter's way of saying thank you to its community for support of DECA chapter activities.

Projects will be presented to a panel of judges who will select the winner. Each chapter will be allowed to bring a team (1-3 members) to the state CDC. There will be no region competition in this event. Presentations will be limited to 10 minutes and will describe the project's goals, implementation and results. Teams may use any audio-visual aids they feel are appropriate for their presentation. Georgia DECA will not provide an electrical outlet. **All** equipment must be provided by the participating teams. Teams will be allowed five minutes to set up their equipment. Teams are encouraged to present written documentation of the Civic Consciousness Project in a DECA scrapbook at the State Conference.
